

# Regional Freight Transport Services



Aurizon is committed to servicing regional Queensland with a combination of rail and road services to meet local freight demand. Aurizon is working closely with local communities and businesses to increase utilisation of general freight services within the regions.

Aurizon has a Transport Services Contract (TSC) with the Queensland Government to provide regional Queensland support for general freight haulage comprising rail and road services. The TSC is valid in 2016 and 2017.

Aurizon offers an efficient, flexible and integrated transport network to meet industry and customer requirements and support the growth potential in regional Queensland.

## General freight services.

Aurizon is working closely with local businesses to attract more freight onto rail by strengthening customer service and freight operations across regional Queensland to cater for the changing needs of customers and

local communities. Aurizon offers customers a full door-to-door national logistics service linking Cairns to Perth.

Through the TSC, Aurizon will provide more than 600 rail services a year from Brisbane north to Cairns and west to Winton.

This includes:

- Five return rail services a week from the Port of Brisbane to destinations including Gladstone, Rockhampton, Mackay, Townsville and Cairns.
- One return rail service a week from Rockhampton to Winton.

Aurizon also offers road freight services to 32 regional communities across Queensland identified in the TSC. Additional deliveries outside the TSC are subject to commercial pricing.

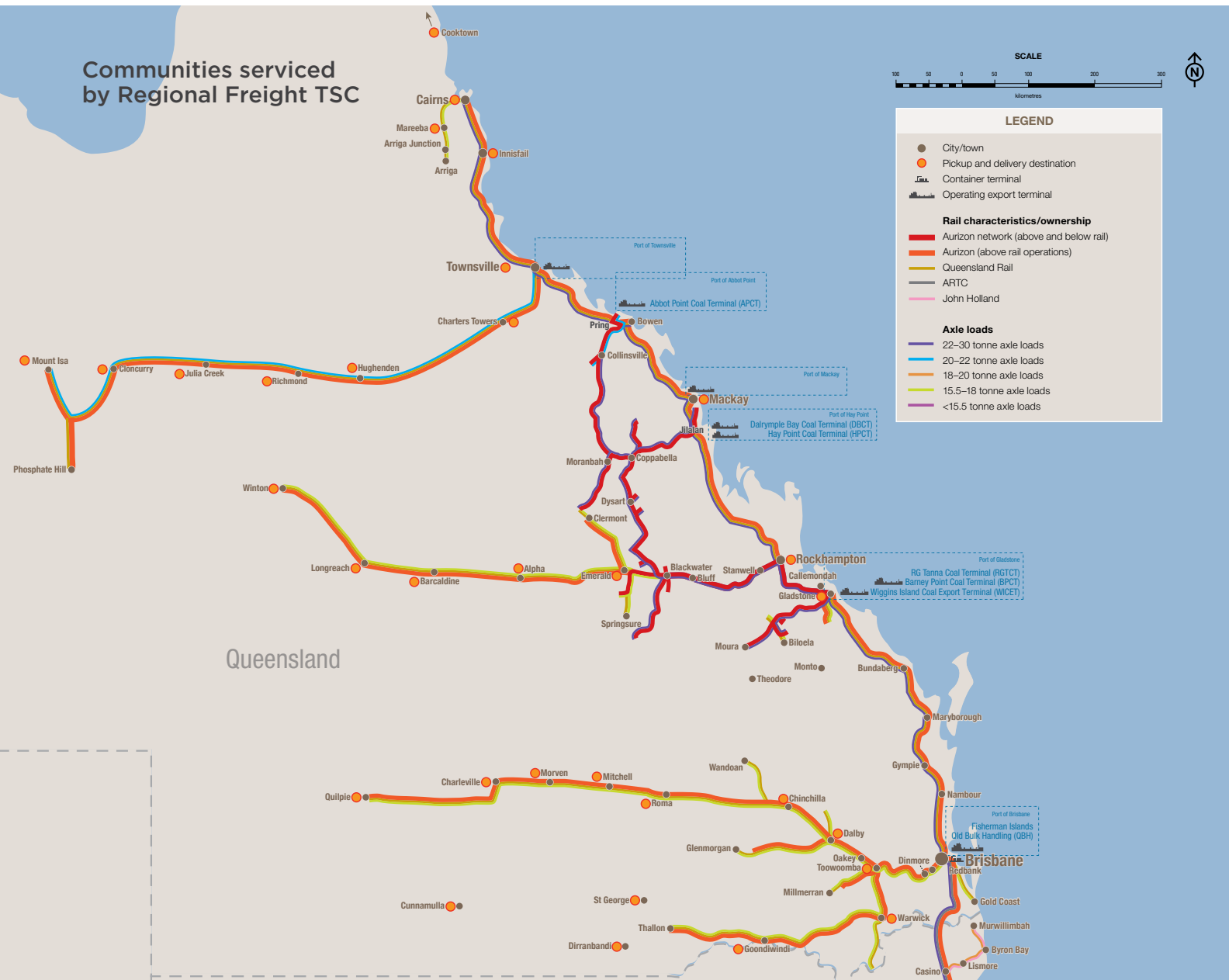
## Why Aurizon?

### Central Queensland (road and rail services).

Alpha, Barcardine, Emerald, Winton, Gladstone, Longreach, Mackay and Rockhampton.

### South West Queensland (road services).

Charleville, Chinchilla, Cunnamulla, Dalby, Dirranbandi, Goondiwindi, Mitchell, Morven, Quilpie, Roma, St George, Toowoomba and Warwick.
